Draft Minutes from the November 2023 meeting were presented for consideration and approved unanimously.						
Executive Committee Reports						
Senior Warden's Report						
Senior Warden Brian Childs thanked Chris Kirwan and David Albrecht for their service to the Cathedral Council and the St. Mark's community. Both members are leaving the Cathedral Council at the end of 2023.						
Report of Treasurer and workshop on 2024 Budget Scenarios						
Ted Sherman provided his monthly Treasurer's report. Clarity was provided regarding several large/non-recurring items in November. The Cathedral had an operating gain of approximately \$42K in November, which brings the full year loss to approximately \$200k.						
Finance Committee Chair Gina Christ led a presentation on the budget for 2024. The Council was walked through the budget spreadsheet, which is a very conservative budget with much work to be done to bring down costs. Anticipated 2024 revenue is largely dependent on total pledges, as the capital campaign efforts remain in progress. A discussion ensued regarding providing the congregation a balanced budget for consideration at the annual meeting. Balancing a 2024 budget will require ~\$200k in cuts. Strategies in communicating these facts and discussing scenarios both before and at the annual meeting were discussed. Interim Dean Lane Hensley discussed these upcoming efforts from his perspective.						
As the 7:00 p.m. meeting cutoff passed for the evening, a special meeting of the Council in the first part of January was proposed to continue budget discussions before the Annual Meeting on Jan. 28, 2024. A Special Meeting and/or a facilitated discussion will be scheduled. Other agenda items were not discussed tonight. Submitted reports from others are referenced.
