Approval of Minutes from the April meeting & The Rev. Tim Kingsley, Provost 7:45 pm YTD Budget Summary Rev. Kingsley moved to approve the April Vestry meeting minutes. This was seconded by Gina Christ and the motion carried at 7:46 pm. **Committee and Commission Reports** 7:46 pm **Governance Committee Report** Brandon Lorge, Committee Member Governance Committee Member Brandon Lorge shared that edits to the bylaws are currently a work in progress, and reminded Vestry members that the Constitution will be voted on in the June Vestry meeting. 7:49 pm **Property Committee Report** Joe Ward, Committee Chair Property Chair Joe Ward started by sharing a breakdown of financials that the Property Committee and Finance Committee will collaborate on rectifying. Financial visioning work will follow about restricted accounts (permanently vs. temporarily restricted) and recent changes in the accounting system. He followed by reporting on the roof claim update. Finally, he shared updates on the Sanctuary Seating Task Force, which has started drafting ideas to address damage to pews in the Nave and get estimates of repair or replacement costs, and the priorities toward bilingual signage and enhanced gender-neutral restroom accessibility. **Finance Committee Report** 8:46 pm Jacob Buchen, Committee Chair Finance Chair Jacob Buchen presented recent financials that indicate the importance of looking into alternative income streams/fundraising.
