Two loans from the cathedral. 1. Bridge loan in the amount of \$235,574.05 cash flow loan \$131,356.93. Both loans are due this month. Extending the terms of both to be due 12/31/2026. A new full agreement will be submitted for signatures.

Income 12,000 worse than plan. Due to donations being lower than plan. Expenses higher than plan. YTD 138,000 loss. Predicts 150,000-200,000 negative margin by year end. Some pledges promised have not been paid. Some estates donations are still coming in both will bring in \$65.000 each towards operations, which will bring the budget close to break even operating performance. 3 scenarios represented in the report, which is still being refined.
